- Lecture delivery method: Blended. Pre-recorded lectures will be recorded and made available to all students registered for the class through Blackboard. It is expected that the students will watch these lectures ahead of the live regular schedule class times. Synchronous/Live lectures will be held during the normally schedule class times. These will be active learning sessions where the instructor and students work problems based on the lecture topic. These synchronous sessions will be recorded and made available for viewing at a later time.
- Textbook: The textbook for this course is a digital pdf and free. It will be made available through blackboard.
- Laboratory delivery method: online synchronous. Normal lab sessions will be used for meeting with the TAs to ask questions about the current week's lab. The lab may be completed asynchronously.
- How the lab will be run
 - There will be 10 lab sessions, starting in week 3 of the semester with a frequency of a lab every 1 week.
 - Student groups: Students will work individually on each lab experiment
 - Pre-lab work: Students will watch a video before starting the lab experiment. The video will be made available at least 24 hours before the lab session. Some pre-lab calculations may be necessary before beginning the lab.
 - Post-lab work: Each student will submit their lab report electronically where it will be graded by the TA and the grade will be made available before the next lab session.
 - Interactions with TAs or Instructor: TAs will be available online for questions during their scheduled lab time. The instructor, TA and peer-help will be available via Piazza.
